Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>The event was held as a one-day gathering of young people from the local community, representatives of local authorities, and civil society. Most of the participants were students from Dalj High School, who had the opportunity to take part in a political discussion. The discussion moderator asked the young participants specific questions regarding their needs and the changes they would like to see in their local community. The theme of the political forum was the establishment of the Youth Council of the Municipality of Erdut, as well as a discussion on what young people expect from the Youth Council as a body meant to represent</p>			

them before local authorities. The second part of the forum focused on a **“Meet and Talk” session** with representatives of local politics as well as representatives of other institutions that play a significant role in improving the quality of life for young people in the Municipality of Erdut. Towards the end of the political forum, based on the discussions and reflections of young people regarding their status and the fulfillment of their needs in the local community, the moderator presented specific conclusions concerning the opinions and attitudes of young people on the effectiveness of and trust in local authorities and politics in general, as well as their views on the establishment of a Youth Council as a body that would represent their positions and demands before the local authorities.
