Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
The workshop was implemented as part of a one-day event and brought together 25 participants, with the aim of increasing young people's awareness of their rights as citizens of the European Union and encouraging their active participation in society. The activity was designed as an interactive educational workshop, providing participants with knowledge about the functioning of the EU, its fundamental values, the rule of law, and opportunities available to young people through EU programmes. The main objective of the workshop was to empower young people to better understand their rights and possibilities as EU citizens, while encouraging them to actively use available opportunities for education, mobility, volunteering, and participation in projects. Through discussions and practical examples, participants were encouraged to reflect on the importance of being informed, engaged, and involved in democratic processes. The workshop was carried out through interactive sessions focused on three main topics: understanding European citizenship and participants' awareness of their EU rights, learning about the structure and			

values of the European Union, and exploring opportunities for young people within EU programmes. Participants actively exchanged opinions, discussed examples from everyday life, and gained a better understanding of how EU policies and initiatives affect their lives.

In conclusion, the workshop successfully contributed to strengthening young people's knowledge about EU rights and opportunities. It encouraged participants to become more active and informed citizens, aware of the possibilities available to them and motivated to take part in creating positive changes within their communities and the wider European environment.
